NOTE: This information supplements the Local Rules and Conditions of Competition for Miami Valley Golf Championships hard card.

FORMAT: 18 - holes of stroke play.

PACE OF PLAY - ALLOTTED TIME: 4-hour and 30-minute pace for the 18-hole round.

THE ONE BALL RULE IS NOT IN EFFECT

DISTANCE MEASURING DEVICES ARE PERMITTED: provided they are used to measure distance only.

RELIEF FROM SEEMS OF CUT TURF - MODEL LOCAL RULE F-7: as prescribed in Section 8 of the Committee Procedures is in effect.

THE MODEL LOCAL RULE F-5.2: is in effect and allows golfers to take free relief from immovable obstructions when both the ball and the obstruction are within two club-lengths of the putting green and in grass cut to fairway height or less.

PREPARED BEDS: are treated as obstructions and the area behind #9 Green is considered part of the cart path that surrounds it. Prepared Beds are defined as areas on the course that have ornamental plantings and some form of ground cover. This does not generally extend to tree wells that have mulch around the base.

BROKEN EDGES OF ARTIFICIALLY SURFACED ROADS AND PATHS - The unmarked Broken Edges of an artificially surfaced road or path are connected to the same abnormal course condition when taking relief under Rule 16.1

WOOD CHIP PATHS: Have the same status as Artificially Surfaced Roads and Paths or are Loose Impediments at the players choice.

OUT OF BOUNDS: Defined by inside of Stake or Fence post at ground level and when both Fences and Stakes are present, Stakes Identify and Fence Defines the Out of Bounds.

SCORING AREA: Please Proceed to Scoring Area Located inside the Clubhouse just to the West of the Putting Green Immediately After Completing your Round.

PLAY-OFF TO DETERMINE THREE QUALIFYING PLACES AND ALTERNATES: In the event of a tie for final position(s), there will be a hole-by-hole play-off immediately upon the completion round. (Qualifying Positions & 2 Alternates). It is the Players Responsibility to be in position for playoff.

HOLE #3: OB Right, Penalty Area

(Optional Ball Drop for Ball Entering Penalty Area)

HOLE #4: OB Right

HOLE #5: OB Right

HOLE #6: Penalty Area behind Green

HOLE #9: Penalty Area Right. OB Behind Green

HOLE #10: OB Left & Behind, Penalty Area Right

HOLE #11: OB Left, Penalty Area Right

HOLE #13: Penalty Area Left & Right

HOLE #14: Penalty Area Left

HOLE #16: Penalty Area Left

HOLE #18: OB Right & Behind Green
